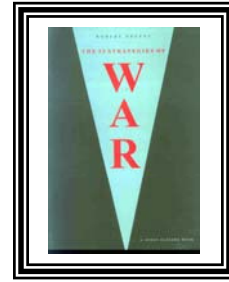


## **THE 33 STRATEGIES OF WAR**
